VINTAGE NOTES

This wine has been crafted utilising fruit sourced from three separate blocks on the estate, comprising two premium blocks of 21-year-old Cabernet Sauvignon vines and a single block of 21-year-old Merlot vines. The north-eastern facing soils are well-drained gravelly loam over granite and clay with average yields of 3 tonnes per acre.

A variety of techniques is employed throughout the vinification process including open-pot fermentation, cold soaking, extended maceration and partial barrel fermentation. The wine is matured for 18 months in 35% new and 65% seasoned French oak barriques.

ANALYSIS

Alcohol 13.5%, pH 3.45, TA 7.1 g/L

TASTING NOTES

Colour Deep ruby red with vivid purple hues.

Aroma The wine exhibits brambly cassis and plum fruit flavours with restrained spicy cedar overtones, hints of mocha and dried bay leaf which adds intrigue and complexity.

Palate The palate unfolds in a myriad of layers of blackberry, plum, and cassis fruit interwoven with savoury oak. The long and flavoursome finish is well supported by dry and fine tannins.
